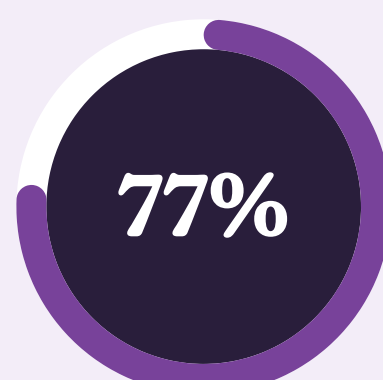
Preferred Training Method
